## Proposed Homeschool Policy

Our Philosophy of Christian Education states that we believe that God has commanded Christian parents to train their children according to the Word of God. Further, we believe that the Christian school is an extension of the home and that we exist to assist Christian families in the training of their children. Consistent with that policy, we realize that assisting Christian families includes those who chose to educate their children at home. We have determined that the most effective means of assisting is to allow homeschoolers the opportunity to enroll for one or more courses that their families deem difficult to be taught at home either because of facilities or expertise.

### Policy:

1. Any homeschooler who has completed 8th grade may enroll for one or more courses.
2. The Master's School will teach and evaluate homeschool students throughout the course of the school year.
3. The Master's School will issue report cards at the end of each quarter.
4. The Master's School will maintain a permanent record of all courses taken at the school and forward copies to institutions of higher education, as requested.
5. The charge for a course will be \$980.00 per semester (approx. \$12.00/day). The application fee, registration fee, re-registration fee, as well as any lab fees, are assessed separately.
6. Homeschool students are eligible to participate in all sports, drama and music programs at an additional fee.
7. Homeschool students have the option to purchase the same school accident insurance as full-time students.
8. Homeschool students are encouraged to participate in all school functions such as chapel and sports activities and attend school concerts to feel part of our school community.
9. Homeschool students are subject to the policies published in The Master's School Middle and Upper School Handbook in all areas not specifically contained in this policy.
