The Master's School is seeking a qualified, self-motivated candidate to teach Computer Science classes in the Middle and Upper School.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's or Master's Degree in Education or Computer Science or related field
- Current teaching license and/or Association of Christian School International (ACSI) certification a plus
- Competence in developing and implementing standards-based instruction in the middle and high school classroom
- Successful experience facilitating guided learning for middle and high school students
- Passion for working with young people; experience in the areas listed above; knowledge of a range of classroom technologies; a desire to work with colleagues in a collaborative environment; the ability to continually seek and implement new technologies and methods of teaching and learning; and a commitment to fostering a diverse community
- Strong communication skills
- A commitment to The Master's School mission

Responsibilities:

- **Instruction**
 - Teach Computer Science classes for grades 6-12 including introductory technology courses that integrate logical thinking, creativity, and basic programming or coding along with more advanced or specified courses in the Upper School
 - Organize and facilitate a Robotics Club and/or Lego League and oversee the school's Makerspace
 - Set appropriate and meaningful student learning goals
 - Engage students in the learning process
 - Utilize frequent assessments to guide learning and provide meaningful feedback
